Any information on Joseph Dubé and Philomène Nadeau who lived in the region of Eagle Lake and Van Buren, Maine in the 1850s. They have known descendants in the United States but we cannot link them to Mathurin Dubé. Gilbert Dubé of Boca Raton, Florida, now a member of the ADA (2008), is one of the descendants.

Descendants of Alfred Dubé and Adèle Ouellet, who likely married in New England around 1890 and lived in Salem, Massachusetts, after 1901. Both were born in St-Aubert de l'Islet, and available documents confirm their marriage. We are very interested in any oral tradition information concerning one of their sons named John Dubé, who would have lived around Springfield, Mass.

Descendants of Olivier Dubé and Marguerite Morin, who left St-Maurice, in the Trois-Rivières region, and emigrated to Turners Falls, Mass., around 1890 with their sons Joseph, Noé and Arthur. In his correspondence in French with Raymond Dubé around 1965, Arthur's descendant Henry referred to numerous cousins living in the US.

Descendants of Magloire Dubé and Aurore Lebrun, born in Amqui. Magloire might have been known as Michael Dubé after his move to the US around 1905. The couple had twelve children. They probably lived around Lawrence, Mass. It is most unlikely that such a numerous family would have left no descendants in the US.

Descendants of Germain Dubé and Amanda Gaudreau, whose existence is confirmed by oral tradition in the Rimouski region and by leads picked up in registers and newspapers around Fall River, Mass.

Descendants of Omer Dubé and Adèle (Hattie) Poirier, who likely married in the US around 1890 and left descendants around Biddeford, Maine.
