Over a decade of solo work, Raymond Dubé advanced tremendously the state of genealogy and historical research for the Dubé families. After he died from heart problems in March 1970, his documents were transferred to the University of Ottawa at the instigation of historian Jean-Claude Dubé. The Association des Dubé is currently promoting his work, particularly his correspondence, as we believe its historical value extends beyond the framework of the Dubé genealogy.
